You may need to become a member to access some of these services.

If you plan to be a landlord in the longer term, you should:

- consider joining a professional body
- undergo accredited training

## Housing Rights

[Housing Rights](#) is a specialist in housing advice, law and policy in Northern Ireland.

The organisation provides [training on a range of housing issues](#) including:

- renting privately
- antisocial behaviour
- houses in multiple occupation
- housing benefit and universal credit

Housing Rights [members](#) can get discounts on training and events.

# Landlords Association for Northern Ireland

The [Landlords Association for Northern Ireland \(LANI\)](#) represents private landlords in Northern Ireland.

LANI aims to:

- promote high standards in managing privately rented accommodation
- engage with government bodies and represent the interests of landlords
- alert members to the implications of changing legislation

Members can get help, information and attend events for free.

## Local councils in Northern Ireland

Environmental health departments in local councils are responsible for a range of housing issues including:

- fitness standards
- fitness certificates
- harassment and illegal eviction
- enforcing legislation affecting tenants and landlords

[Belfast City Council](#) is responsible for licensing houses in multiple occupation (HMOs).
